





## **Progress Update/Key Milestones**



The above pedestrian route plan is now fully operational. It has been developed following a period of consultation with the various stakeholders around the Science Area. Pedestrians are kindly reminded to stick to these routes around the area

Temporary props have been installed. Capping beam is now complete Excavation down to the basement is well under way. With the bulk excavation there has been up to 80 - 90 wagons a day entering the site, to take away earth.



Programme of Works

The Biochemistry Completion works are planned to last 109 weeks, from 12<sup>th</sup> November 2018.

Once the bulk excavation is complete the construction structure will start. During this period, there will be days where up to 35 concrete pours take place with 35 concrete wagons a day entering the site.

Ongoing works the Liner wall is well underway, currently at North elevation working from Lower ground floor to ground floor and Phase 1 works.

Noisy works in the coming weeks will be limited. We will notify Science Area users if there are noisy works for any length of time.

The planned completion for the project is late 2020. Further updates will follow.
