Features of RP.com

- Create and save your own searches
- View and save workgroup searches
- Set up weekly email alerts from saved searches
- Save individual opportunities you are interested in to a folder of bookmarks
- Share searches and individual opportunities

What are Workgroups?

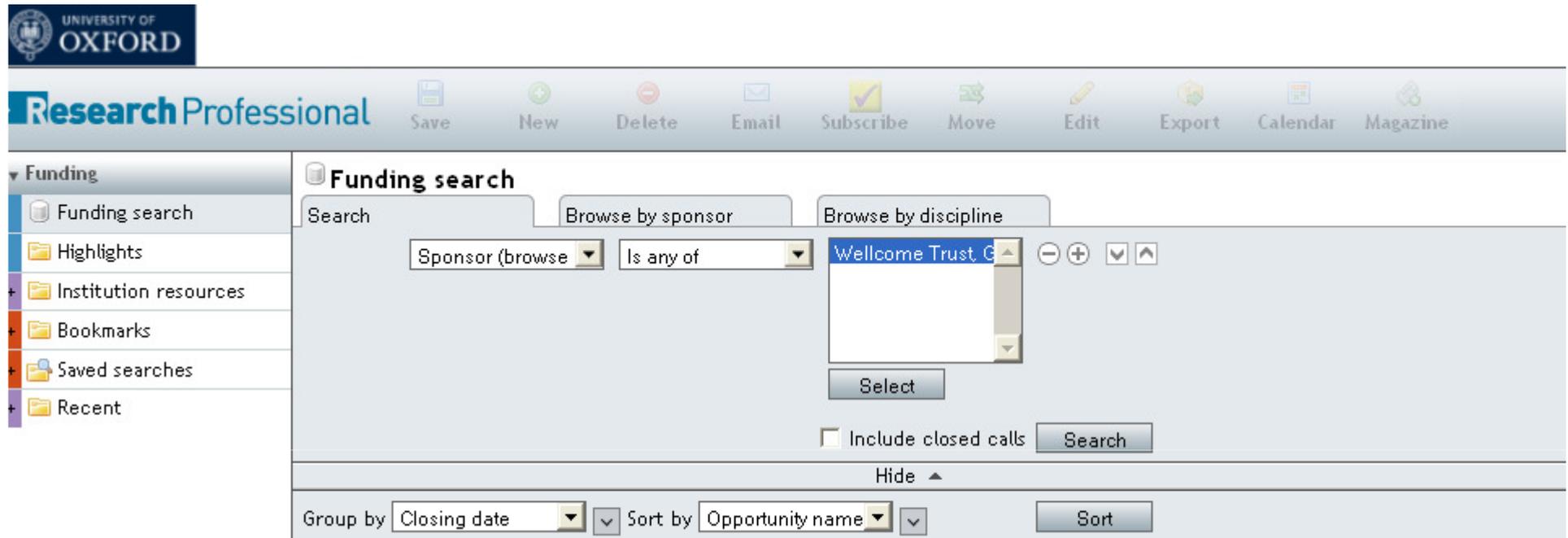
- Online space within RP.com to group and share tailored information just for users at Oxford
- Each workgroup has a home page that contains tailored content of interest to that group.
- Each workgroup has an editor(s) that control the content.

Content

- Saved searches (dynamic)
- Folders of book-marked funding opportunities (static)



Searching RP.com



- By sponsor and specific funding schemes from sponsors
 - By discipline
 - By award type
- and also combine with criteria such as:
- Closing date / Days until closing date
 - Date posted on RP.com / days since posted
 - Full text
 - Include or exclude sponsors by country



Searching RP.com - Rodman Index

An index of disciplines used by RP.com to categorise funding opportunities, it is organised into three levels, e.g.

- Biomedical, Medical Sciences, Health (top-level)
 - Disciplines & Fields, Biomedical, Medical & Health & Safety (second-level)
 - Cancer Biology(third-level)

Searching RP.com - Combining criteria

- AND, AND NOT, OR
- Each operator acts upon the result of all previous criteria (apart from OR, will always search entire database)

Example searches:

Early career funding: can search by:

- Major sponsors e.g. MRC, Wellcome Trust, BBSRC, Cancer Research UK
- Discipline e.g. Biomedical, Medical Sciences, Health, Specialties of Medical & Allied Fields, Oncology
- Award type: select:
 - Predoctoral fellowships
 - Mid-Career fellowships
 - Young investigator awards
 - Predoctoral training fellowships
 - Postdoctoral training fellowships

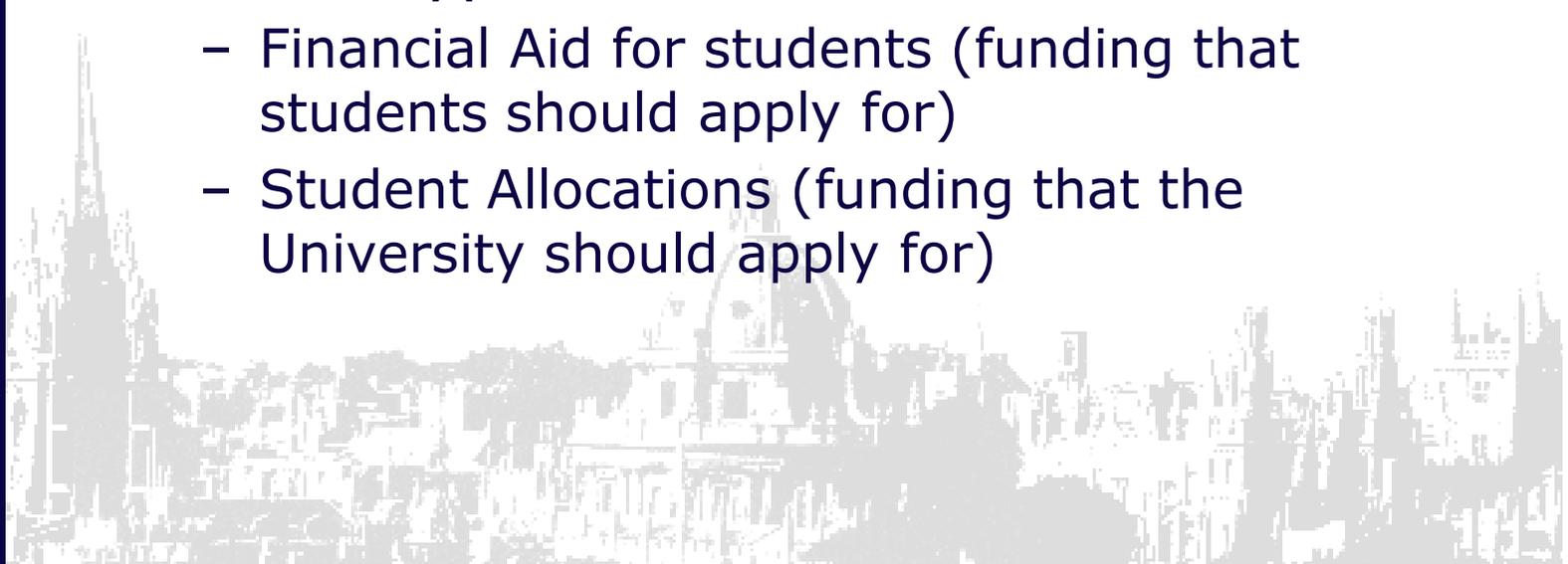

PhD funding: can search by:

- Major sponsors e.g. MRC, Wellcome Trust, BBSRC, Cancer Research UK
- Discipline e.g. Biomedical, Medical Sciences, Health, Specialties of Medical & Allied Fields, Oncology
- Award type: select:
 - Financial Aid for students (funding that students should apply for)
 - Student Allocations (funding that the University should apply for)

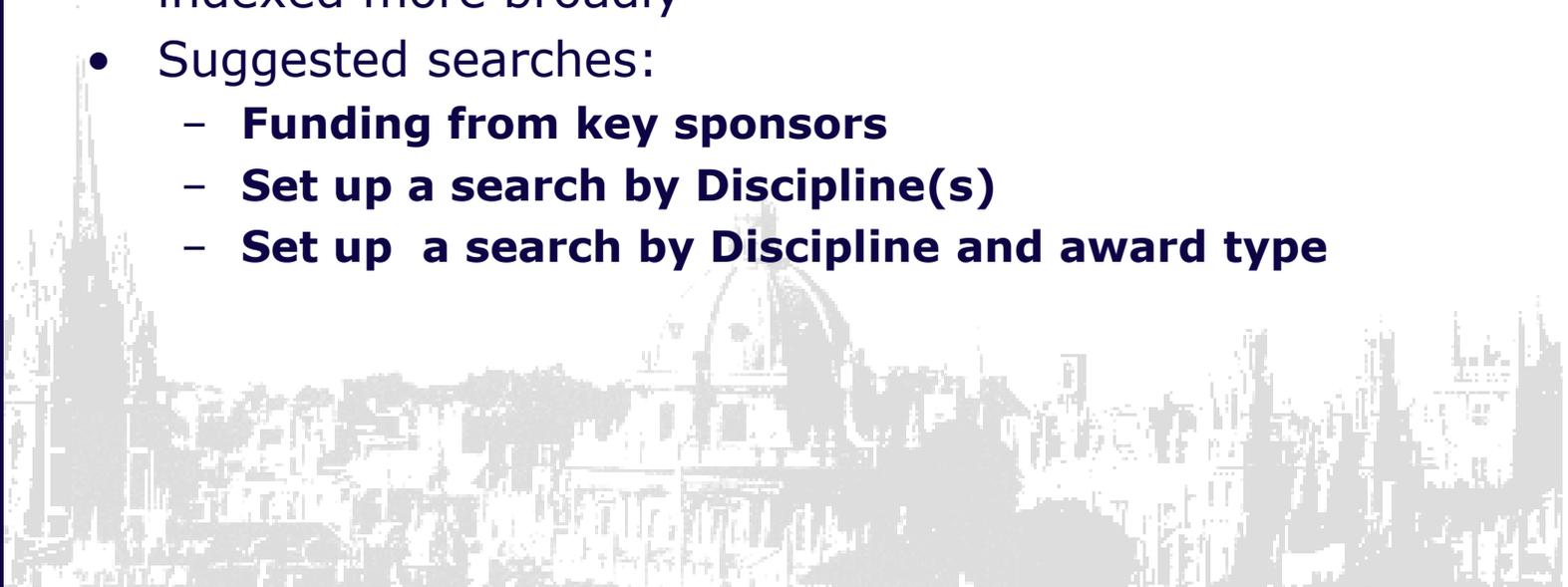

Quick search tips

- Avoid searching just with Free text
- But can be useful to really narrow a broad Discipline search
- Search the Rodman Index for terms relating to your Discipline, may be surprised at the specific terms listed
- BUT also try broader discipline terms – a grant can be applicable to your specific research area but be indexed more broadly
- Suggested searches:
 - **Funding from key sponsors**
 - **Set up a search by Discipline(s)**
 - **Set up a search by Discipline and award type**

- Create a user account on **<http://www.researchprofessional.com>** (click 'Self-register') while on the Oxford network
 - User log ins and passwords are case sensitive
 - You must enter an ox.ac.uk email address
- Browse the site
- Explore the workgroup homepages (in Directory section) and become a member of those you are interested in
- Set up your own saved searches (in Funding section) and subscribe to email alerts based on these
- Collect any interesting funding opportunities into funding folders ('Bookmarks')
- Request new workgroups from relevant divisional workgroup administrators – why not become a workgroup editor yourself?
